Eastern Water and Sewerage Company Limited Introduces A Pay Slow Scheme For New Connections

Chipata City-16th April 2019. Eastern Water and Sewerage Company Limited has once again demonstrated its commitment to make access to clean, adequate and affordable water supply and sanitation services easy for the people of Eastern Province and Chama district by introducing a Pay Slow Scheme promotion for new connections.

This is barely two (2) months after the company announced the Connect 2500 Campaign which aims at making 2500 additional households access clean, adequate and affordable water supply and sanitation services by end of 2019.

The Chabooka promotion will make it easier for the first One Thousand (1000) potential customers who will be connected upon making a Six Hundred and Sixty Kwacha (K660) upfront payment. The remaining balance of Six Hundred and Sixty Kwacha (K660) out of the One Thousand Three Hundred and Twenty Kwacha (K1, 320) standard new connection fee will be paid within the subsequent three months after the connection is done.

Eastern Water and Sewerage Company Limited has set 30th May 2019 as the last day for the Chabooka promotion.

Eastern Water and Sewerage Company Limited Acting Managing Director, Eng. Aaron Mulinda has urged people of Eastern Province to take advantage of the flexible payment plans under the Chabooka promotion to get connected to Eastern Water and Sewerage Company Limited water supply.

Mr. Mulinda has further clarified that the Chabooka promotion will not cover those customers coming from areas where there is an existing Public Private Partnership agreement between the company and the people of that area.

He said potential customers under such project areas are still covered by the same conditions of the contract adding that the company will work towards completing all the projects under Public Private Partnerships.

The Chabooka promotion is part of the Connect 2500 campaign in which the company seeks to provide safe water supply and sanitation services to an additional 2500 households in the year 2019 as outlined in its Strategic Business Plan.
